QCF NVQ Diplomas require that a Learner demonstrates their competence in performing work skills and use of knowledge at their place of work. The nature of working at height on roofs will present severe difficulties to less

able-bodied persons in respect of access to the work area.

Assessors and trainers must take into account any learning difficulties or physical disabilities of the Learner when arranging assessments. If special arrangements, facilities or training is required for the Learner then this must be

referred to the Internal Quality Assurer (IQA) and the Training Co-ordinator for liaison and action as necessary.

A copy of this policy will be issued to the learner on completion of their registration for a QCF NVQ Diploma.

Note: The term 'Learner' includes all persons registered for NVQ awards, all persons enrolled on apprentice

training programmes and all training course delegates.
